1932 : Creation of the « ministère de l'Education Nationale »


Depuis 2020, le ministre de l'éducation est Jean-Michel BLANQUER.

In France, education is mandatory from 3 years old (Emmanuel Macron) to 16 years old (De Gaulle 1959)

Jules Ferry was a famous minister of education under the Third Republic

He created FREE and SECULAR mandatory primary education For boys AND GIRLS aged 6-13

6-11 years old

- •CP (Cours Préparatoire): reading and writing skills

- •CE2 (Cours élémentaire 2ème année)
- •CM1 (Cours moyen 1ère année)
- •CM2. (Cours moyen 2ème année)

Le collège: Junior High



4 years

- •6ème
- •5ème
- •4ème
- •3ème

At the end of the 3^{ème}: FIRST NATIONAL EXAM: le Brevet des collèges

L'enseignement professionnel/ professional-vocational

You go to a « professional high school » (Lycée Professionnel »)

2 years to get

- le **CAP**: certificat d'aptitude professionnelle : for one specific job
- le **BEP** -brevet d'enseignement professionnel- for a more general training into one special field (ex: trade, salesman...)
- •Le Bac PRO in 3 years : higher level than BEP

Le lycée: High school



3 levels – 3 years

- •Seconde
- •Première
- Terminale

In Terminale, there is a final exam called THE BACCALAUREAT

Its process has been changed in 2019

THE « NEW BAC »

Before 2019:

- Seconde was general
- •Première: you could specialize into literature, maths and sciences, economics or management)
- •Terminale: same

Bac L ou ES ou S ou STMG

All the exams were in June (written and oral) and your grades in this **final national exam** ONLY were taken to pass the Bac

After 2019:

- Seconde
- •Première:
- Terminale

In première, students choose 3 major: 4 hours each
In terminales they only keep 2 major 6 hours each

60% of the final grade comes from the grades during the school year BUT: in French, Philosophy and in the 2 major, there is a written FINAL exam **40%** final grade

L'enseignement supérieur: High education

In France there are three otions:

- Universities
- •Les « Grandes Écoles » and specific schools (ex:
- nurse): very sélective
- Shorter studies to learn a job BTS, BUT (2 years)

UNIVERSITIES



3 LEVELS:

la licence/ Bachelor degree: 3 years

Master 2 years after the Bac helor degree

PHd: 3 years

In France there are only **PUBLIC** universities and there are pretty cheap


Les Grandes Écoles

- •The most famous are
 - L'École Nationale d'Administration (ENA): high level public servants, politicians
 - L'École Polytechnique : very high level scientists
 - L'École des Hautes Etudes commerciales (HEC) high level trade, management, economics
 - les Écoles Normales Supérieures (ENS) very high level teachers
- •TO GET IN THOSE SCHOOLS, THERE IS A <u>VERY SELECTIVE</u> EXAM (concours d'entrée)
- •2 Years are needed to prepare for this exam into some selective CLASSES PREPARATOIRES

High Education: SHORT TRAINING

After 2 years, students get qualified into one specific job. These studies are usually based on practice and lots of interneships

- ·Les sections de techniciens supérieurs: to get a **BTS** (Brevet de technicien supérieur)
- ·Les instituts universitaires de technologie (BUT) to get a BUT
- ·Specialized schools: physiotherapists, Nurses, Midwives....: **3years**
